

### Pupil Premium Action Plan 2017/2018

**Number of eligible pupils - 129 (37.3%) (NOR -346)**

**Pupil Premium Income - £195,940**

#### Target - Reading

To reduce the gap between school pupil premium children and the national non-pupil premium children at the expected standard to less than 5% in Year 6 **or** be on track to reach this target in Years 3 to 5.

*2017 school pupil premium children 71.4%, national non pupil premium children 76.6% (5.2% gap)*

To reduce the gap between school pupil premium children working at greater depth compared to national non-pupil premium children working at greater depth to below 2%.

*2017 the gap between school pupil premium children and national non-pupil premium children working at greater depth was 2.8% (national gap 15.1%).*
