The 'Maths – No Problem!' series is used to develop children's mastery of mathematics.

Differentiation is achieved by emphasising deep knowledge and through individual support and intervention.

Teachers and other adults use precise questioning to deepen understanding.

Intelligent practice is used to develop procedural fluency.

The large majority of pupils progress through the curriculum at the same rate.

Use of resources helps children to build a deep conceptual understanding.

Marking takes place during the lesson and early interventions are made to help all pupils keep up.

Practice and consolidation are essential. Spiralling allows children to deepen their understanding.
