Target - Reading

To maintain the performance of pupil premium children at a higher percentage than the national non-pupil premium children at the expected standard in year 6 **or** be on track to reach this target in years 3 to 5.

2016 school pupil premium children 76.3%, national non pupil premium children 71.6%.

To reduce the gap between school pupil premium children working at greater depth compared to national non-pupil premium children working at greater depth to below 10%.

2016 gap between school pupil premium children and national non-pupil premium children working at greater depth was 15%.
